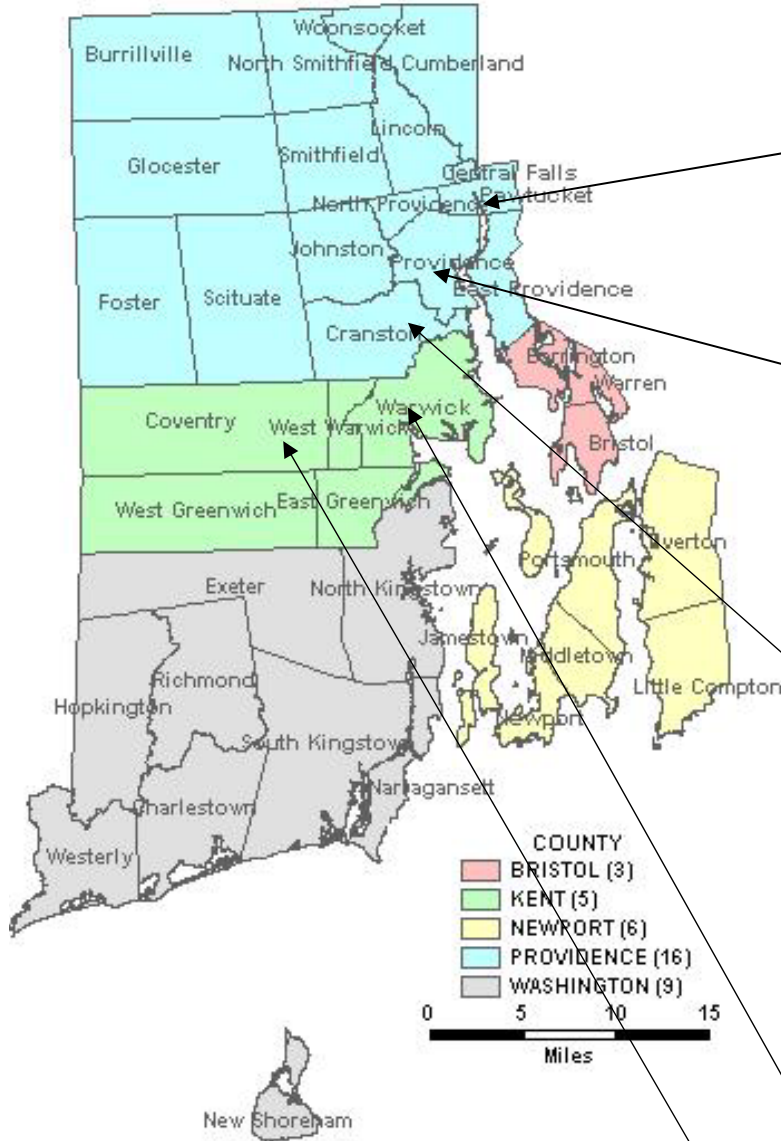

Comprehensive Community Action Program (CCAP) has been serving people since 1965. The Agency was established under the Johnson Administration's Economic Opportunity Act of 1964 "to fight the war on poverty in America".

Comprehensive Community Action Agency has, over the last forty years, expanded its service delivery base to include a wide variety of social service programs capable of providing assistance to the disadvantaged children, youth and adults throughout the various stages of their lives. CCAP has also expanded its geographic service delivery area to include Scituate, Foster, and Coventry. Other Community Action programs provide services in Providence, North Providence, Providence, Smithfield, Johnston, North Smithfield, Burrillville. Exeter, West Greenwich, Pawtucket and Gloucester. In addition some programs are open to people on a statewide basis.

The Agency has addressed many problems facing the disadvantaged and has been highly successful in delivering services to those in need effectively, efficiently and fairly. An extensive knowledge base has been developed within the Agency to identify the needs of the poor and to implement plans of action to meet those needs.
