Comprehensive Community Action Program (CCAP) has four Skills and Youth Centers. Our **Learn to Earn Program** is one of the largest GED and Jobs Training program in RI. The programs are located in Cranston, Providence, Warwick, and Pawtucket.

The goal of the program is to recruit youth that have dropped out of school and do not have the academic/social/life skills needed



for employment. The program engages hard to reach youth by providing them with academic classroom instruction and job readiness training.

Our success reflects the intensive case management and counseling services not found in similar programs. The overall objective of the program is to:

- **Strengthen the participant's academic and career/life skills**
- **Identify and remove barriers to employment**
- **Promote positive youth development**

Youth are better prepared to enter the workforce or seek additional training once they have completed our programs.

Basic Skills Training - A combination of Adult Basic Education skills training, GED preparation and life skills.



Work Readiness and Occupational Skills Training – Using curriculum based learning, participants develop skills in areas such as interviewing, work relationships, time management, conflict resolution and problem solving.

Paid & Unpaid Work Experience – Based on the participant's job readiness skills, they may be placed in either a paid or unpaid work experience with one of our collaborating business partners. Participants will also be encouraged to seek employment in the private sector.

Case Management and Counseling Services— Clinical and concrete services that are designed to address supportive service needs outlined in the Individual Service Strategy.

Youth Development - Through curriculum-based youth development services, young people learn to meet their basic personal and social needs and to build competencies which are necessary for a successful adolescent and adult life. Services focus on stressing the youth's competencies, strengths, and developmental needs while working on problems and weaknesses.

All programs have income and residency eligibility requirements. Additionally, students must be able to read at the 8th grade level. For more information about CCAP's Learn to Earn Program call 437-8885.

Based on household income, you may be eligible for bus fare, mileage reimbursement, and free parking in the Providence Place Mall Garage. We also offer incentives to qualified students.

The **Learn to Earn Program** is located in the Providence Skills Center (in Providence Place Mall), the Warwick Skills & Youth Center (in the Buttonwoods Community Center), the Pawtucket Youth Center, and the Cranston Youth Center.
